

HE LINCOLN MEMORIAL is one of America's most famous and popular landmarks. The inscription on the wall above the statue of President Lincoln reminds visitors that "In this temple, as in the hearts of the people for whom he saved the Union, the memory of Abraham Lincoln is enshrined forever."

Work on the Lincoln Memorial started in 1914 and took eight \_\_\_\_ to complete. Abraham Lincoln's only surviving child, Robert \_\_\_\_ Lincoln, attended the \_\_\_\_ ceremony on May 30, 1922.

New York architect Henry \_ \_ \_ \_ , who designed the Memorial, was inspired by a Doric temple in \_ \_ \_ \_ , the birthplace of democracy. The Memorial is built with stone from different parts of the country: \_ \_ \_ \_ from Massachusetts, \_ \_ \_ \_ \_


